Instructions to the candidates

HOW TO APPLY:

- Candidates should apply only through online in the Website www.nifftea.ac.in.
- Before applying, the candidates should have scanned image of their photograph.
- A valid e-mail ID or Mobile Number is mandatory for registration.
- Please note that all the particulars mentioned in the online application including Name of the Candidate, , Date of birth, Address, Email ID, will be considered as final and no modifications will be allowed after the last date specified for applying.
- Candidates are requested to fill in the online application form with the utmost care as no correspondence regarding change of details will be entertained.
- Candidates are required to upload their photograph. An online application is incomplete without the photograph upload.
- After submitting the application, candidates can print /save their application in PDF format. On entering e mail id and date of birth, Candidates can download their hall ticket and print.
- Candidates should carefully fill in the details in the On-Line Application at the appropriate places and click on the "SUBMIT" button at the end of the On-Line Application format. Before pressing the "SUBMIT" button, candidates are advised to verify each and every particular filled in the application. The name of the candidate etc. should be spelt correctly in the application as it appears in the certificates/mark sheets.

Note:

I. Candidates are advised in their own interest to apply on-line much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/failure to log on the NIFT-TEA website on account of heavy load on internet/website jam.

ii) Do not bring into the Examination Hall any article such as books, electronic or any other type of calculators, mathematical and drawing instruments etc. However candidates applying for AFD & CDF courses can bring the required drawing tools such as color pencils, water colours, crayons, sketch pen etc. for drawing test.

ii) Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items included mobile phones / pagers to the venue of the examination, as arrangements for safekeeping cannot be assured.
